### **KEY TAKEAWAYS:**

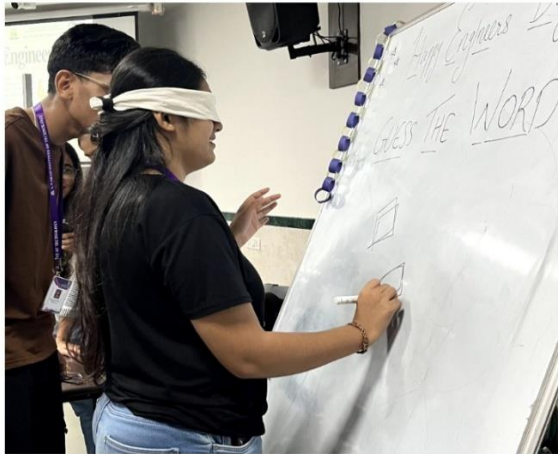
- Strengthened the bond among students across different branches.
